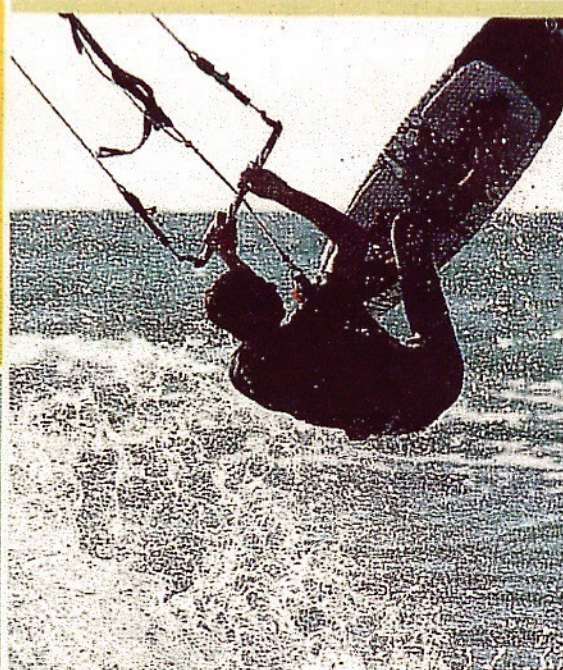
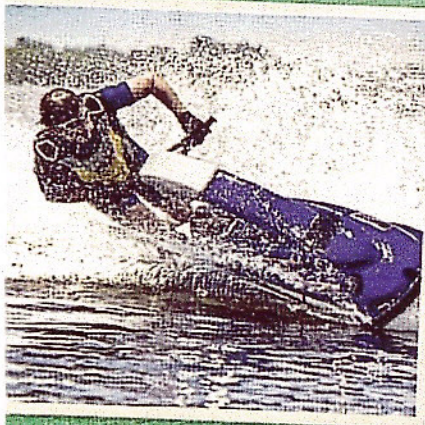




# Wild Rides
